What is this all about?


- 2 x 4-week exchange + preparation and follow-up




Urban Gardening: Amari Refugee Camp




Urban Gardening: Siegen Refugee Camp

Schedule

- □ Application Deadline: January 25th 23:59
- Notification of Participants **and** kick-off: January 30th (notification in the morning, kick-off meeting at 6 **pm**)
- Preparing Sessions (sometime between February 1st and February 15th) – we will send a poll
- □ First period in Palestine: around February 22nd and March 22nd
- Reflection and first wrap up: around end of March, Beginning of April

- Insurance (health insurance: travel update)
- Vaccinations
